# Minister Cox participates in 45th Annual Conference of the Caribbean, Americas and the Atlantic Region of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association

The 45th Annual Conference of the Caribbean, Americas and the Atlantic Region of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association (CPA) in Turks and Caicos kicked off earlier today, July 24, 2023, and will continue until July 27. Senator the Honourable Donna Cox, Minister of Social Development and Family Services, was one of the many Government Officials in attendance. It is anticipated that practical solutions can be formulated to combat these issues facing the Caribbean region.

Among others, also in attendance were Senator the Honourable Nigel de Freitas - President of the Senate; and Senator Dr. Varma Deyalsingh.
