There was also a cocoa estate with a cocoa house which later served as the village school.

After having attended the Guapo Government School, Mrs Sylvester served as a teacher and later became principal of the Salazar Trace Government School. In her spare time, she occupied her herself with sewing, embroidery and gardening. At this stage of her life however, she likes to eat, sleep and talk.

Ms Iris, advises parents and teachers to continue to encourage children to demonstrate good behavior. She adds that it may not always be necessary to punish them with 'licks', however there are times that it is necessary to 'gih dem the rod'. She advises the younger generation to love the Lord, work hard, pray, obey their parents, keep the commandments and live in harmony with one another. She attests her long life to having peace and contentment and family unity.
