## "Brother Sonny" celebrates 100 years

True to his faith, the devout Christian and man of God celebrated the milestone with a Prayer and Thanksgiving Service, further crediting his longevity to going to church.

Scores of family, friends, and well-wishers gathered for the celebration, including his sister, Jane Nero-Barriteau, who will celebrate her ninety-third birthday in November. The event was held at his Barataria home, which also housed his business, Unity Furniture. A skilled joiner, a trade he learned from his uncle, Mr. Nero managed his business until he was ninety.

Joining the celebration also was Minister of Social Development and Family Services, Senator the Honourable Donna Cox. During her brief remarks, Minister Cox expressed her gratitude to the family for their dedication to the care of their older relatives, emphasising its contribution to their longevity. Minister Cox then presented Mr. Nero with his Certificate of Honour and Achievement, a birthday cake and two hampers from sponsors the Kiss Baking Company Ltd., National Flour Mills and Vemco.

In his greetings, Mr. Nero's son Wayne spoke about the importance of parenting, emphasizing how his father's diligence and dedication had profoundly impacted his children, leading them to pursue professions such as nursing, engineering, and accounting.
