An intimate celebration was hosted in honour of the achievement on Friday 25th October, 2024 in St. James. Other distinguished guests included the Honourable Keith Scotland SC, Minister in the Ministry of National Security and Member of Parliament for Port-of-Spain South and His Worship Alderman Chinua Alleyne, Mayor of Port of Spain.



She reminisced about her days with Dr. Eric Williams, emphasising the importance of unity and love among people. She further encouraged everyone to live together, love one another, and stay connected.

In celebrating Ms. Forde's birthday, Minister Cox encouraged persons to register and inform the Ministry of anyone they know who is one hundred years old or nearing that milestone for the National Centenarian Programme. She emphasised that although there are over two hundred individuals on the Ministry's register, this figure may not accurately reflect the centenarian population within the country. Minister Cox also commended the Ministry's Division of Ageing for their unwavering commitment to the Programme. Following her remarks, she presented Ms. Forde with her Centenarian medal, Certificate of Honour and Achievement, along with hampers and a birthday cake graciously provided by sponsors Vemco, National Flour Mills, and Kiss Baking Company.
